The project is staffed mainly by volunteers from the community together with young people on government training schemes. If you would like details of volunteering opportunities please contact us:

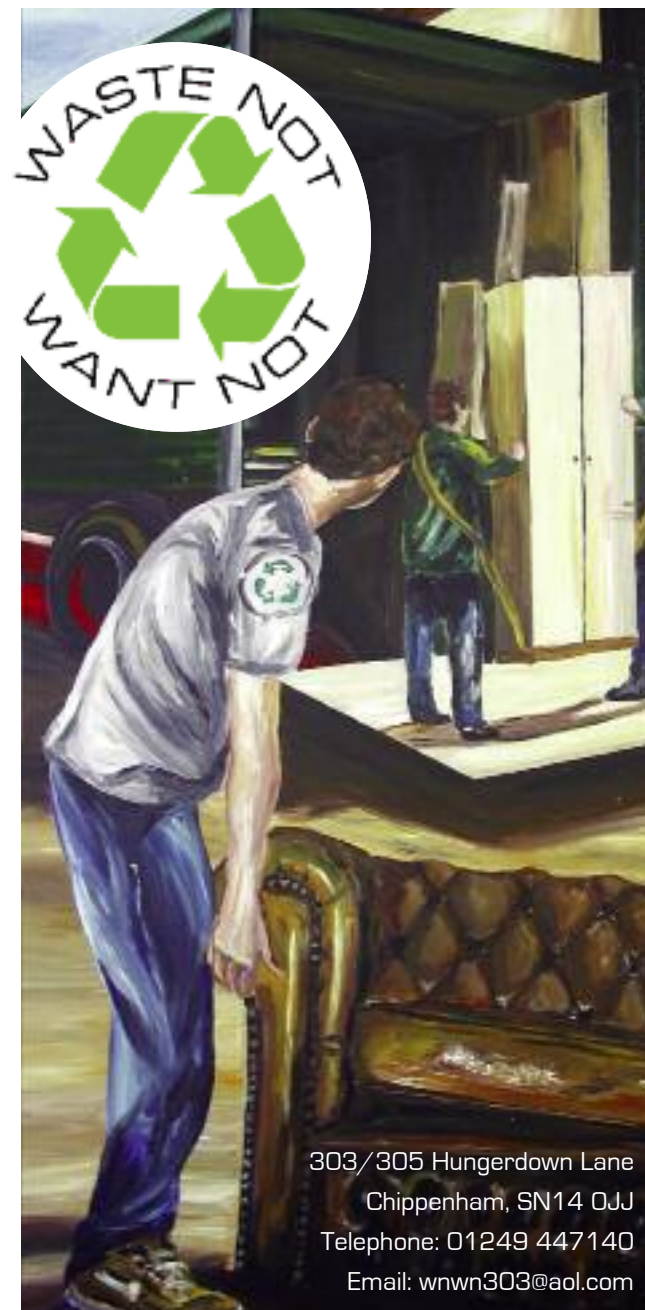

What is Waste Not Want Not?

Waste Not Want Not is a registered charity that collects, free of charge, unwanted items of serviceable furniture and household goods to pass on at affordable prices to families and individuals on low income and all senior citizens.

Where is Waste Not Want Not?

The furniture and household goods showroom has ample car parking and is situated at 303/305 Hungerdown Lane, Chippenham, SN14 0JJ (near to the Tesco garage and shop).



What types of goods are available?

The range of items typically available include:

- Three piece suites
- Beds and mattresses
- Dining tables and chairs
- Fridges and freezers
- Bookcases and bunk beds
- Wardrobes and bedside tables
- Electric cookers
- Microwaves

We have a large showroom to display the wide range of quality used furniture and household goods that are offered for sale. Prices vary depending on item, but three piece suites are offered at around £50 or £60; double beds from £40; and fridges from £30. Waste Not Want Not does not sell to the general public so our low income client base does get the pick from all the items on show.

What are the opening hours?

The showroom is open from 9.30am to 4pm Monday to Thursday and from 9.30am to 3pm on Fridays.

Who can make purchases?

Waste Not Want Not is for people on low income who may be in receipt of any of the following: Income Support, Housing Benefit, Working Family Tax Credit, Disability Allowance, etc. Waste Not Want Not is also pleased to supply goods to all senior citizens and students in full time education. Evidence of qualification may be requested to support any purchases.

Our achievements

During 2007 Waste Not Want Not:

- assisted 2067 people* on low income furnish their homes with safe and serviceable furniture and household goods;
- collected goods from 1181 household in North Wiltshire
- diverted approximately 93 metric tonnes of reusable goods away from landfill
- provided volunteering, training and work experience to 29 individuals including 8 people rehabilitating after mental health or drink / drug issues and 6 individuals on Government Training schemes.

(*Most of WNN's clients have partners and many have children so it is likely that, during 2007, the project helped more than 5000 people achieve a more pleasant and comfortable lifestyle.)
