

We'd like you to vote for the names of the new streets in Culverhay.



Members of the Culverhay steering group formed a sub-committee to come up with the name suggestions for the new streets.

Because Cricklade Town Council requires street names chosen to have a local connection, or a reason behind the choice, we also asked the local historical society for suggestions.

Once the list was compiled, it was then sent to the Town Council and Wiltshire Council for their approval.

Local birds:

1. Egret
2. Heron
3. Skylark

Local flowers and trees:

4. Willow
5. Clover
6. Bramble

Anglo-Saxon heritage:

7. Penny (link to the old Saxon mint in Cricklade)
8. Blythe (Saxon word meaning cheerful)
9. Sidley (Saxon word meaning friendly)
10. Unity (Saxon word meaning togetherness. This is also a type of house being demolished in Culverhay)

Simply come along to our community event between 3pm and 6.30pm on 22 May 2017 on the green (or in the fire station if it's raining) and cast your votes.
