Can you do this?

Referral process and criteria

As part of the referral process an individual's circumstances will be assessed to establish if the service can meet their support needs.

- Referrals can be made by any agency / professional or by the woman herself.
- Women referred must be at risk of domestic abuse from either a partner, ex-partner or family member, and have no access to any other safe accommodation.
- Referrals where there is no recourse to public funds will be considered dependent on funding available for accommodation and sustenance.
- Families with a male child up to the age of 16 years will be considered.

A place of safety

Refuge Support Service

Short-term emergency accommodation for women, with or without children, who are fleeing domestic abuse.

What is domestic abuse?

Any incident or pattern of incidents of controlling, coercive, threatening behaviour, violence or abuse between those aged 16 or over who are, or have been intimate partners or family members regardless of gender or sexuality. The abuse can encompass, but is not limited to:

- psychological and emotional
- physical and sexual
- financial

Who are we

North Wiltshire Women's Refuge is a service offering support to both single women and women with children who are fleeing domestic abuse.

The service operates as part of GreenSquare's Support Services.

The support offered is accommodation based and is provided in two locations.

What we do

We work with both families and individuals in crisis to enable them to gain and maintain personal safety and have control of their situation.

How do we do this

- Assess the risks
- Safety and support planning
- Multi-agency working

Areas of support covered

HOUSING

- Assisting in planned safe return
- Assisting with dual housing benefit / suspended benefit / benefit overpayments / discretionary payments
- Assisting with rent arrears
- Liaising with both social and private landlords
- Supporting homelessness applications

BENEFITS

- Maximising income

LEGAL OPTIONS

- Providing information on options available to promote safety of women and children

SIGNPOSTING

- Identifying other agencies that can support women and families impacted by domestic abuse

Are they choosing refuge?

ENCOURAGE PLANNING IF POSSIBLE

Useful information to collect:

- Identification / for yourself and children if applicable
- National insurance number
- Proof of income / benefits
- Bank details / cards / cheque book
- Money
- Medication
- Spare keys to your property
- Any log numbers relating to incidents

ADVISE YOUR CLIENT NOT TO DISCLOSE THEIR PLANS FOR LEAVING TO THE PERPETRATOR

Encourage them to find a safe place to keep the information and personal items that they need.

Suggest that there might be someone who they can trust to look after this until they leave.
